Get Started with Pearson's MyLab & Mastering and Canvas0My Lab Access Code

With the purchase of your textbook package, you have a MyLab Access Code. You will redeem the code during the registration process.

If you do not have an access code you can use a credit card or PayPal to purchase instant access online during the registration process (temporary access is also available).

MyLab Registration Preparation

Where do you register and what do you need?

- 1. Register in your Canvas course (do not register through the Pearson MyLab and Mastering Website).
- 2. You need your Embry-Riddle email address for registration.
- 3. You need your MyLab access code or purchasing agent (credit card, PayPal account, or the decision to use temporary access).

MyLab Registration Process

Returning Students: If you are a returning Canvas/MyLab & Mastering user, you will NOT need to go through Step 3 in the registration process described below because your accounts are already linked. The system will automatically bypass that step.

- 1. Access MyLab and Mastering located in your Canvas course menu. Select the "MyMathLab Course Home" option.
- 2. Accept the End-User License Agreement and Privacy Policy.
- 3. Sign In with your Pearson username and password. Use the "forgot username/password" link if you cannot remember them. If you do not have a Pearson account, create one. (NOTE: You CANNOT connect your Canvas username/password to more than one Pearson username/password. You MUST retrieve your old Pearson login credentials.)
- 4. On the next webpage, click the *Access Code* button if you purchased a package with an access code from the bookstore, OR purchase instant access now by clicking on the purchase options under the *Use a Credit Card or PayPal* section. You may also select *Get temporary access* without payment for a specified amount of days.
- 5. You have now registered! You can close the "congratulations" tab and return to your Canvas course. This process only needs to be completed once.

From now on, only access your MML user interface via MyLab and Mastering in the course menu. (Do not use the Pearson MyLabs website.) Once you enter the MyLab and Mastering Canvas webpage, you can select any of the MyMathLab links, and it will open the MML user interface in a new tab.
